Alan Shearer was back playing at Wembley on Tuesday to help launch The FA UMBRO Fives

The former England captain retired from the game last summer, but has not lost the edge in front of goal that helped him score 18 times in 35 games for the Three Lions at the old Wembley.

Shearer joined up with a team of 'John Terry's' for the launch of The FA Umbro Fives and commented:

"If you asked any professional footballer what he wants to do in training, he'd always say he'd like to have a game of five-a-side. You can just go out and play and you all get a lot of touches and lot of shots at goal. It's a great way to play the game.

With a Finals place at Wembley on offer, over 5,000 teams are expected to take part in The FA Umbro Fives.

Sir Trevor Brooking, The FA's Director of Football Development issued a message of encouragement to any potential entrants to the competition: Anyone could play at the Wembley Finals.

"At the old Wembley it was a very rare occasion if anybody was actually allowed on the pitch, so The FA Umbro Fives giving the chance to come here and play is very unique. At whatever level of skill you're at, if you take part in the competition

you could end up playing here. There are going to be eight 'lucky losers' in addition to the final 32 at Wembley, so it keeps it open for everyone to know that they could come and play at Wembley and sample this unique atmosphere."

Logistique have been commissioned by The FA to undertake the coordination of the football competition which will include scheduling local heats, and overseeing the operational side of the 9 Regional Finals and Wembley showpiece.

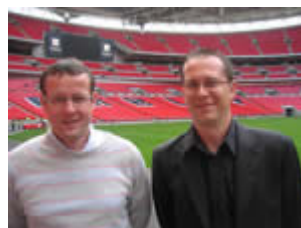
Logistique have now completed half of their grand tour of the country managing the first FA Cup for five-a-side football, at the new Wembley Stadium. The tour has seen teams compete in the East, North East, Yorkshire and North West regions.

The remaining leg of the tour will see further teams compete in East Midlands, West Midlands, London, South East finishing in the South West in early June.
